



## **Grilled Baby Eggplant Parmesan**

#### Ingredients

Ingredient Checklist

4 small (10 to 12 oz. each) eggplants, halved lengthwise

1 teaspoon kosher salt, divided

2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

1 cup jarred marinara sauce



2 ounces Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese, grated (about 1/2 cup)

8 ounces fresh mozzarella cheese, thinly sliced

1/4 cup small fresh basil leaves

#### **Directions**

Instructions Checklist

- **Step 1**Preheat a gas grill to medium-high (400°F to 450°F) on 1 side. Sprinkle cut sides of eggplants evenly with 1/2 teaspoon of the salt, and let stand 10 minutes. Pat dry with paper towels.
- Step 2 Brush cut sides of eggplants evenly with oil, and sprinkle with pepper and remaining ½ teaspoon salt. Place eggplants, cut sides down, on oiled grates over lit side of grill. Grill, covered, until eggplants are tender and grill marks appear, 4 to 6 minutes. Turn eggplants. Cook, covered, 5 minutes.

#### Step 3

Move eggplants to oiled grates over unlit side of grill, and top evenly with marinara, Parmigiano-Reggiano, and mozzarella. Grill, covered, until cheeses are melted and bubbling, 3 to 5 minutes. Transfer to a serving platter, and sprinkle evenly with basil leaves. Serve immediately.


